



Huron High School Parking Permit 2019-2020

We encourage all students to take full advantage of our bus transportation. However, when a student finds it necessary to drive, the school district is not responsible for any injury or loss incurred by the student in route to school, or the return home, and/or while the vehicle is parked on school grounds.

During the school year, only vehicles with a HHS parking permit for the current year will be allowed to park on school premises in designated areas. The Cost is \$25.00.

Students who do not have the official HHS Parking Permit will not be allowed to park on school property. Students violating this policy could have their vehicle towed at the owner's expense and be subjected to a ticket by the Huron Township Police.

Please note: Students need to plan accordingly to be to school on time. Arriving a minute before school starts is not planning appropriately. The doors entering the school will be locked at the minute warning bell and students will need to walk to the front of the building to enter through the office and sign in to school late.

Administration has the right to search any vehicle parked on school property when, "Safety of students is involved". A violation outlined in the student handbook has been violated or Administration has reasonable cause to suspect.

During the school day, students who are in the parking lot without Administration's permission are subject to lose his/her driving privileges and are subject to other disciplinary actions. Also, leaving school property without Administration's permission this includes signing out for lunch is not permitted. Students must drive safely and slowly on school grounds abiding safety procedures.

Failure to follow these guidelines and the ones outlined on the back of the sheet will result in a minimal loss of driving privileges for two weeks to the permit being completely revoked and any other disciplinary actions that are appropriate for misuse or inappropriate behavior.

STUDENT PARKING PERMITS

Students who drive or ride a motorized vehicle to school will park in the Student Parking Lot or areas designated by the Assistant Principal (Ms. Megan O'Brien). The vehicle may not be moved until the student is dismissed from school. Students must receive written permission from a Teacher or Administrator to park in an area other than the Student Parking Lot.

Students who park in an unauthorized area will be ticketed and/or towed at their expense.

Parking rights can be suspended for a minimum of two weeks up to the remainder of the school year. This will be determined by Administration.

If a student must leave school for an emergency, the student must obtain Administrative permission. Failure to adhere to the regulations will result in the student's parking privileges being revoked.

GENERAL REMINDERS

1. PARKING IS A PRIVILEGE AND NOT A RIGHT.
2. All students must have a parking permit displayed in their windshield in order to drive his/her car on school property.
3. Parking Permits Cost \$25.00 per year (Non- Refundable).
4. If a car is used to leave school property without Administration Authorization, the student may lose their driving privileges as mentioned above.
5. Students found driving carelessly in the parking lot may lose driving privileges as mentioned above.
6. Students who purchase a parking permit during the second and third trimester will pay \$25.00 for the rest of the year.
7. Parking permits are valid for the school year in which they are purchased **(that year only)**.
8. **Students who accumulate 5 or more tardies/sign-ins to school per trimester could lose their parking privileges for two weeks.**
9. **Students that are repeatedly leaving school grounds to "go home" or "go out to parking lot" may have their pass revoked for a period of 2 weeks or forfeit driving privileges remainder of the school year.**
