

PARKING PERMITS

We encourage all students to take full advantage of our bus transportation. However, when a student finds it necessary to drive, the School District is not responsible for any injury or loss incurred by the student enroute to school, or the return home and or while the vehicle is parked on school grounds.

During the school year, only students who have the Huron High School mirror-parking permit will be allowed to park on school premises. The permit will cost \$20.00. Students who do not have the official Huron High School parking permit will not be allowed to park on school property. If a student's automobile is in the parking lot without an official permit, it may be towed at the owner's expense. Our office hours are 8:00a.m. to 3:00p.m., Monday through Friday, for your convenience. Please fill out the form below and present it to Mrs. Vogel for your permit.

Administration has the right to search a vehicle on school property when the safety of other students is involved.

Any student in the parking lot without permission will lose driving privileges for 2 weeks. Leaving school property with an automobile will result in a two-week suspension of parking privileges. Huron High School has the right to revoke students' permit if they fail to drive safely and courteously while on school property.

STUDENT PARKING PERMITS

Students who drive or ride a motorized vehicle to school will park in the Student Parking Lot. The vehicle may not be moved until the student is dismissed from school. Students must receive written permission from a teacher or administrator to park in an area other than the Student Parking Lot. Students who park in an unauthorized area will be ticketed. Parking rights may also be suspended for a 30, 60 or 90 day period. This will be determined by the administration.

If a student must leave school for some emergency, the student must obtain administrative permission. Failure to adhere to the regulations will result in the student's parking privileges being revoked.

1. Parking is a privilege and not a right.
2. All students must have a parking permit in order to drive his or her car on school property.
3. Parking permits cost \$20.00 per year (Non-refundable).
4. If a car is used to leave school property without administration authorization, the student may lose their driving privileges for a 30, 60 or 90 day period.
5. Students found driving recklessly in the parking lot will lose driving privileges for up to a 90 day period.
6. Students who purchase a parking permit during the second or third trimester will pay \$20.00 for the rest of the year.
7. Parking permits are valid for the school year in which they are purchased (1 year only).
8. Students who accumulate 5 or more tardies/sign-ins to first period per trimester, will lose their driving privilege for two weeks.
